## Mind Over Matter

There exist today numerous conflicts located throughout the globe, but none are as devastating and catastrophic as the "battle for the mind" that is being waged on the human race. Whether you are in the Middle East, Burma, India or North America, this conflict continues to be fought on an ongoing basis . . . and the outcome is not that encouraging.

How powerful is the mind? We are learning even in today's fast paced technological era that not only does space or the waters below the earth hold untold stories and secrets . . . so does the human mind, and God's call to win this battle becomes ever so more relevant for us today. The Apostle Paul pleaded in Romans 12:2 **"Do not conform to the pattern of this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind.**

***Then you will be able to test and approve what God's will is - His good, pleasing and perfect will."***

Here's a simple concept with not so simple repercussions, "Neurons that fire together...wire together." What does an overhaul of the mind look like, what does "transformation" entail, and how far are you willing to go to better your odds at testing and approving God's will for your life? When God saves us from sin, He just doesn't want to see an outward change in us, but a complete inner transformation of the way we think.
